For this program, we will begin with the woven square that is #7 from last years Chapter Challenge. Bring two colors in the darkest values to start.

Value is the relative lightness and darkness of a color. Bring a color wheel, if you have one. I will have examples to share. More directions will be available on our website. This should be a fun project. I'm looking forward to everybody participating.
